Large E-commerce project made from youtube tutorial and hours of documentation and debugging research in Stripe, Next-auth, and Sanity docs and githubs.

- Tech: Next.js, TailwindCSS, Sanity.io, Redux, Stripe, Next-auth, Typescript
- Built functional E-commerce project modeled after Apple.com using sanity as the backend using their client and custom schemas to query for products with GROQ query language.
- Plugged in stripe in test mode to allow for handling and processing of payment information.
- Used next-auth for 'sign in with google' functionality and to create users in sanity studio. Sanity studio allows for non programmers to add products to the site and inquire about user purchase habits.
- Redux toolkit was used to hold cart data as users added items to the cart and were passed through the Stripe checkout process.

- Tech: Sanity, Next.js, TypeScript, TailwindCSS
- Used Sanity headless CMS as a backend plugin and real-time database for the comments and articles in the app.
- Created schemas and TypeScript Interfaces to ensure clear modeling of data so the backend knew what shape to expect from user data.
- Fixed breaking changes within Sanity's tooling since the next-sanity 5.0 release removed createImageUrlBuilder from the package.

Real Estate site landing, search, and details page displaying data pulled from Bayut's API with additional code built to handle some missing data.

- Tech: Next.js, Chakra UI, Bayut API, CSS, HTML, Vercel
- Documentation deep dives, investigating the integrated dependency functions in node modules, and querying various API endpoints.
- Found inconsistencies in the retrieved API data resulting in unexpected blank fields. Used ES6 ternary to display "UNAVAILABLE" so users know that the boolean value was left blank, but keeps the page shape the same.
